

It's a good organ (as opposed to an outstanding one like Bjerkreim). Built in 1971 by a not-particularly-good Norwegian company, the console and much of the action was replaced 16 years later by the (much better) Danish firm of Bruhn, the whole organ re-intonated in 1990 by a Swiss and German partnership and a new mixture added in 2001 by Jehmlich Orgelbau of Dresden.
